Video casinos and education contributions

Video lottery casinos near Long Island -- Resorts World in Jamaica, Queens and Empire City in Yonkers -- are providing more revenue to education than are casinos in seven other locations throughout the state, according to a nationwide study of gambling for the Rockefeller Institute of Government in Albany.
