


Learn From What Others Have Done

- Built upon the ACA


Lessons Learned







Progress through Partnerships




Quality and Patient Safety Improvement

GME Resident FTEs Training at Hospitals by State











Where NYS Medicaid Dollars Are Spent









The Growing Federal Deficit (in billions of dollars)








