New Yorkers Born in Haiti

According to the US Census, there are **144,585 New Yorkers born in Haiti**. Haitian-born New Yorkers are a slightly female-majority population (**55.1% female; 44.9% male**) and have a **median age of 54**, reflecting a mature and established community across New York State. Citizenship is also widespread: **103,589 Haitian-born New Yorkers are US citizens (about 71.6%)**, while **40,996 (about 28.4%) are non-citizens**.
